

Teacher's Assistant Job Description

Great River Montessori (GRM) is seeking a dedicated and qualified individual to join our teaching and caregiving staff. We are accepting applications for both part-time and full-time positions. Specific hours will be outlined on the Employment Availability form.

GRM provides a **Montessori-based curriculum** for children ranging from infants through 12 years old.

Position Details

Infant - 3K Schedule

- Position start date: September 2, 2025 (includes a training day and open house in late August).
- This is a year-round position and will continue until terminated by GRM or the employee.
- Daily schedules and activities may vary based on the age of the child, weather, and program needs.

School Year (4K - 6th Grade) Schedule

- Position start date: Early September (includes a training day and open house in late August).
- This position **concludes at the end of May**, with the possibility of continued employment during the summer and into the next school year.
- Schedules and activities may vary depending on student needs, weather, and program availability.

Responsibilities

- Assist in implementing a daily schedule of activities for children.
- Help create age-appropriate teaching materials and lesson plans.
- Engage children in a variety of learning experiences, including stories, songs, games (indoor and outdoor), art, and movement.
- Enforce school and classroom expectations while fostering a positive learning environment.
- Maintain accurate records, including attendance, incident reports, and observations.

- Identify **behavioral challenges** and collaborate with lead teachers to implement appropriate strategies.
- **Supervise** children in the classroom, between classes, during lunch and recess, and on field trips.
- Provide caregiving support, including assisting with meals, hygiene, and rest periods.
- Communicate **professionally and promptly** with staff, students, and families.
- Support substitute teachers and volunteers as needed.
- Have fun while fostering a warm and engaging classroom environment!

- High school diploma required.
- Experience working with children is preferred but not required.
- Basic knowledge of child development is a plus.
- CPR and First Aid certification (or willingness to obtain).
- No prior Montessori experience is required, but a willingness to learn the Montessori approach is essential.

- Strong organizational and time management skills.
- Ability to **stay calm and patient** in a fast-paced environment.
- Professional, clear communication with children, families, and colleagues.
